### SCHOOL ARRIVAL TIMES

Students should not arrive at school before 8:15 except on Tuesday and Thursday when they may arrive at 7:45am for Breakfast Club. Before school, children with parents should be seated and wait outside their class. Children without a parent must wait in the undercover area until dismissed by the teacher on duty.

### AFTER SCHOOL PICK UP

Our school closes at 2:30pm. Please be prompt to pick up your child at that time and if needed organise After School Care with the local Day Care Centres. After school use of playground equipment must be supervised by a parent. Thanks for your cooperation to keep our children safe.
