EXCURSION TO: Woodman Point Recreation Camp, Coogee.

PURPOSE OF EXCURSION:

- Students will learn to operate as a team and communicate effectively;
- learn about effective community membership;
- develop independence and interdependence;
- develop skills in outdoor recreation activities.

DATE: Monday 22nd November until Wednesday 24th November 2021

PLANNED ACTIVITIES:

Team and individual challenges including, archery, mountain biking, flying fox, rafting, beach sports, team games, escape from quarantine and orienteering.

TRANSPORT: Bus/coach

COST:

The total cost of the camp is **\$235** which includes accommodation, transport, food and activities.

A non-refundable deposit of **\$50** is due by the end of Term 3, **Friday 27th August 2021**

ACCOMODATION AND FOOD

Students will be housed separate boys and girls' dormitory facilities.

This camp will be catered by Accolade Catering who are the nominated caterers for all Department of Sport and Recreation Camps.

Woodman Point 2021- GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

BRING ANY MEDICATIONS OR PERSONAL AIDS THAT MAY BE REQUIRED TO ALL ACTIVITIES

A bag containing;

- Appropriate comfortable clothing
 - 4 changes of clothing (t-shirts, shorts, pants, socks etc.)
 - Clothing appropriate for water based activities (bathers or shorts and tee shirts)
 - Jumper or wind proof jacket or warm clothing depending on conditions
 - Nightwear
 - Hat
 - Sunscreen
 - Soap
 - Hair brush / comb
 - Tooth brush and paste
- 2 pairs of closed in shoes (Sneakers); including a pair that can be worn in water
- Sleeping bag
- Pillow
- 2 towels
- Water bottle
- Mobile phones will be allowed at the camp, however no other electronic devices will be permitted. Students will be expected to surrender the mobile phone to the supervising teacher who will store it in a secure location. Phone use will be limited to calls to parents and carers under supervision between 5.00 and 6.00pm.

Students will be expected to;

- Treat all participants as they like to be treated. Respect the privacy and personal space of other individuals.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Cooperate with their instructor and other participants.
- Never argue with an instructor or other participants.
- Demonstrate independence and participate for their own enjoyment and benefit.
- Take leadership. Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays.
- Work equally hard for themselves and/or their team.
- Accept responsibility for their own actions.
- Enter only the dormitory allocated to them for the duration of the camp.
- Remain in segregated areas as designated by the camp coordinators and staff
