### Independence – Key for success (Crèche available)

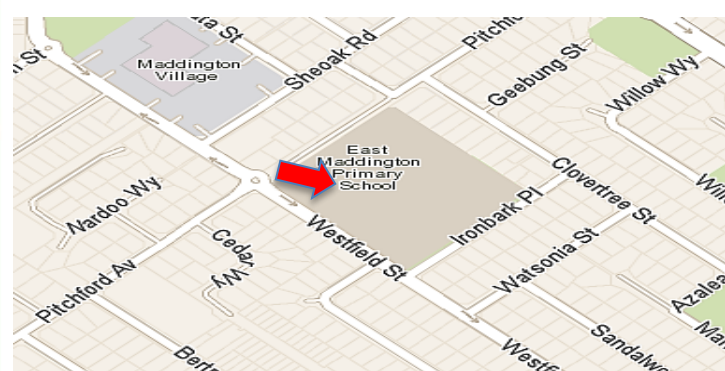
As children get older it is important for their development to learn to do things for themselves including the importance of routines, and responsibilities. Facilitated by Department of Education. **Bookings required.**
